Wednesday Night Bible Studies

Wednesday evenings are our dedicated time to dig in to God's Word and grow together. Community is a primary component, and circle tables will promote a setting geared toward sharing and listening. Each fall and spring, Faith Women will have two 8 week sessions. Each session, three Bible study options will be provided. You will have the chance each 8 weeks to get to know a new group of ladies and build community together.

Another new component of Wednesday night Bible Study will be a once a month Big Group time. Big Group will give us all a chance to come together, regardless of what group we are a part of, to hear about what is going on, share about mission opportunities, and lift up prayer requests and praises. My hope is that this Big Group week will give us the chance to unite as ladies of Faith and grow closer together! Generally, we will aim to have Big Group on the first Wednesday of each month, however with holidays and other church calendar items, this date will change.
