Family Discussion Questions

1. Is there anyone else you know of, besides Jesus, who can feed five thousand people with just five loaves of bread and two fish?
2. What do we learn about Jesus here as He feeds five thousand people with the five loaves of bread and two fish?
3. In verse 11, Jesus gives thanks for the food. Who do you think Jesus is giving thanks to? And why is it important to do that?
4. Verses 12-13 tell us that there was leftover food after the five thousand people had eaten. Jesus provided more than enough to eat. In what ways is Jesus "more than enough" for us and in our life?
5. "God's grace" is His gifts that we don't deserve. God's forgiveness of our sins, providing us eternal life even though we don't deserve it, giving us Jesus' righteousness, providing us food and water, are some examples of His grace for us. What do we deserve as a result of our sins? How is God's grace more than enough?
6. Share with each other how God has been kind to you.
